Music

Disc Golf

The disc golf tournament promises to be an exciting event for both seasoned players and newcomers to the sport. The 18 holes are spread across 50 acres of beautiful, preserved state park land, making for a challenging and picturesque course. Participants will have the opportunity to

showcase their skills in various contests, such as the putting contest, EDGE SkillShot, and longest aloft. The tournament will feature two days of daytime disc golf, and two rounds of glow disc golf, adding an extra level of excitement to the competition. And for those who excel in their play, there is the grand championship to strive for.

Everyone is welcome, whether or not they have played disc golf before. This event is focused on fun, community involvement, and celebrating Harford County.

What is Disc Golf?

Disc golf is played much like traditional golf. Instead of a ball and clubs players use a flying disc, or Frisbee®. The sport was formalized in the 1970's, and shares with "ball golf" the object of completing each hole in the fewest number of strokes (or, in the case of disc golf, fewest number of throws). A golf disc is thrown from a tee area to a target which is the "hole". The hole can be one of a number of disc golf targets; the most common is called a Pole Hole® an



elevated metal basket. As a player progresses down the fairway, he or she must make each consecutive shot from the spot where the previous throw has landed. The trees, shrubs, and terrain changes located in and around the fairways provide challenging obstacles for the golfer. Finally, the "putt" lands in the basket and the hole is completed. Disc golf can be enjoyed by people of all ages, regardless of economic status.

The museum is housed on 23 acres with 23 buildings. SFM is operated by a small staff and volunteers. It has hosted tens of thousands of visitors through the years. SFM's mission is to preserve and interpret the rural heritage of Harford County, MD. They provide educational tours,
